

October 14th, 2024, Meeting Notes Members 11 present

- **Grand Knight:** Dave opened the meeting and talked about Christopher Columbus on Columbus Day. Dave also encouraged us to recruit new members. - Financial Secretary: 71 Total members, 47 associates, 20 insurance, 4 inactive, 3 Honorary, 27 Honorary Life, 4 inactive and 0 EXM. Jim reported no money is owed at this time.
